---Sen. Lamar Alexander, Tennessee Republican, said the Democrats' bill was "scaring the daylights out of Americans." But Mr. Reid chided the Republicans for their unwillingness to continue debate on the measure.

"I say to my Republican senators, don't try to silence a great debate over a great crisis," Mr. Reid said on the Senate floor moments before the vote. "Don't let history show that when given the chance to debate and defend your position to work with us for the good of the country and constituents, you ran and hid." (How blind is Reid? Late Saturday night, our noble U.S. Senate bought enough votes (barely) to move Harry Reid's healthcare bill to the floor for debate, beginning sometime shortly after Thanksgiving.

In a move that can only be described as pure bribery, Louisiana Senator Mary Landreau received some \$300 million in Medicaid subsidies in exchange for her "Yes" vote on moving the bill forward. Blanche Lincoln, of Arkansas, also agreed very late to vote "Yes", but we don't know what the payoff was on that one yet.

Two things that are important for all Americans to take away from this event. One is that two U.S. Senators, and probably more, were willing to oppose a significant majority of their constituents in their respective states, in exchange for some federal money to offset what this bill will force states to pay for all the unfunded mandates imposed on them by Reid's bill. The language of the bill amendment stated, for Landreau, that this subsidy, or exemption, applied to any state that, "seven years ago" was declared a "national disaster area". As luck would have it, only Louisiana fit that qualification. Isn't that amazing? One Senator described Lanreau's payoff as "The New Louisiana Purchase". We agree. America got a much better deal with the original version. By the way, the other states in the country don't get that subsidy. Their citizens will have to eat the tax increases that are coming in order to pay for state Medicaid under this bill. Idahoans should feel wonderful about that, right? continued on page 3---

ACORN-A STORY NOT TO FORGET

It appears that Acorn's scandalous behaviour, which the federal government certainly was aware of years earlier, is not going to be overlooked this time. Thanks, in part, to The Heritage Foundation, it will not be swepted under a rug.

This story is important on so many levels of fraud, lies and cheating that has cost the American taxpayers, millions of dollars..

To preface this story; American taxpayers spend over \$100 million a year to fund the Congressional Research Service, a "think tank" that provides reports to members of Congress on a variety of topics relevant to current political events. Yet, these reports are not made available to the public in a way that they can be easily obtained.

The CRS ignores the recent news reports on undercover videos documenting the acts of ACORN employees in encouraging and engaging in possible conspiracies in numerous offices to suborn mortgage fraud, bank fraud, tax fraud, and human trafficking in underage girls for prostitution. The CRS also ignores the comprehensive report issued by Representative Darrell Issa (R-CA), Ranking Member of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform. This report found that "structurally and operationally, ACORN hides behind a paper wall of nonprofit corporate protections to conceal a criminal conspiracy on the part of its directors, to launder federal money." It intentionally blurs "the legal distinctions between 361 tax-exempt and non-exempt entities [in order to divert] taxpayer and tax-exempt monies into partisan political activities."

Senator Charles E. Grassley (R-IA) also issued a report on ACORN concluding that "dollars raised for charitable [purposes] appear to be used for impermissible lobbying and political activity." ACORN has received more than \$53 million in federal funds since 1994 and is eligible for stimulus funds. Congressional concern over an entity and its subsidiaries that receive taxpayer funds engaging in numerous possible violations of state and federal law is more than enough justification to meet any test applied by a court trying to determine the reasonableness and rational basis for such legislation.

State and federal law enforcement agencies routinely sue corporations on the theory of vicarious liability, and state governments routinely pull the operating license of a corporation if an individual employee neglects to properly comply with state requirements to maintain such a license. In some cases, such vicarious liability may seem unfair, but it is perfectly constitutional to debar an entire company from receiving government contracts or grants because of one or more employee wrongdoers. DESPERATE ACORN-SUING

Acorn, the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now, filed suit in federal district court in Brooklyn today, claiming Congress violated the Constitution-

Acorn's complaint says Congress, by extending the ban to "allied organizations," violated Acorn's First Amendment rights of free speech and association. This stops groups from working with Acorn, they said. And finally, it says Congress violated Acorn's due process rights.

The Center for Constitutional Rights, a legal advocacy group based in New York City, is representing Acorn, whose complaint also names White House Budget Director Peter Orszag and Treasury Secretary Timothy Geithner as defendants.

Acorn, one of the nation's largest community organizing groups, had been receiving \$2 million to \$3 million yearly in federal funds.
