GOVERNOR OTTER STANDS UP FOR IDAHO- RECEIVES NATIONAL ATTENTION!

(BOISE) – Hailing it as a reflection of public dismay with Washington, D.C., and a clear expression of State sovereignty, Governor C.L. “Butch” Otter welcomed legislative sponsors to his office at the Capitol today for the signing of House Bill 391 – the Idaho Health Freedom Act. “Congress and the White House are working out their scheme for pushing through a healthcare ‘reform’ bill that has more pages than the U.S. Constitution has words. I guarantee you that not a single member of the House or Senate has a complete understanding of that legislation any more than they understood all the implications of the USA PATRIOT Act back in 2001,” Governor Otter said. “What the Idaho Health Freedom Act says is that the citizens of ourstate won’t be subject to another federal mandate or turn over another part of their life to government control.” The legislative cosponsors of House Bill 391 – Representatives Jim Clark of Hayden Lake, Raul Labrador of Eagle and Lynn Luker Boise, along with Senator Monty Pearce of New Plymouth – joined the Governor at the signing ceremony to celebrate a victory for Idaho’s selfdetermination.

The Idaho Health Freedom Act also takes into account the work that Idaho already is doing on its own to promote greater accessibility and affordability to healthcare for all Idahoans. That involves working closely to create and nurture public-private partnerships to develop primary care medical homes throughout Idaho, expand medical residency programs, expand the safe and secure electronic exchange of health information, and improve the voluntary enrollment of Medicaid-eligible children.

THE FIVE KEYS TO KILLING OBAMACARE

1) Fight the Democrats on Reconciliation. Republicans are saying that they’re going to do anything and everything in their power to block the further damage

2) Challenge the bill in court. It’s clearly unconstitutional to force people to buy insurance. If the government can force you to buy insurance as a condition of citizenship, why couldn’t the Congress just as easily write a bill forcing you to buy a car from GM?

3) Win the public relations war. So far, we’ve won the public relations battle over this bill, but that doesn’t mean we’re guaranteed to win it forever. It’s entirely possible that Obama and health care reform will get a temporary bump from passing health care reform. That’s not the least bit unusual after a big bill like this passes. Happily, that bump will be destined to fade, but expect Democrats to play the PR for all it’s worth.

4) The Republican Party has to win big in the next two elections. Here’s the sad reality: Republicans need to win 10 seats to take back the Senate, 40 seats to take back the House, and we need to defeat Barack Obama in 2012.

5) Repeal, replace, and refuse to fund. To completely repeal this bill, we’re probably going to need to control the House, have 60 votes in the Senate, and hold the presidency. Obviously, that’s a heavy lift -- particularly getting to 60 in the Senate. However, in the interim, if we can control Congress, we can start tearing this bill apart, piece-by-piece. We can try to get unpopular parts of the bill, like the tax hikes and the individual mandate, repealed. Congress also controls the purse strings; so we can shut down large parts of the plan by simply refusing to fund it. Moreover, we can suggest popular conservative ideas to replace unpopular parts of the bill and force the Democrats to either continue to go against the will of the people or vote them in. Then, if and when we get the votes and the presidency, we can try to repeal the whole thing. Don’t let anyone tell you that this will be easy. But, don’t let them tell you it’s impossible either.

Cannon: "To hear Democrats tell it, the CBO projects the legislation would cost a mere \$940 billion over the next 10 years...the actual cost of the bill is nearly \$3 trillion."

THE AFTERMATH OF OBAMACARE:

What America Will Look Like If The White House Gets Its Way

A picture of America’s future under Obamacare can be revealed, though, after peeling away the pages and digging through the dirt. Here’s 10 things you can expect:

1. A Massively Engorged Government, to the tune of \$2.5 trillion in new entitlement spending. According to the Congressional Budget Office (CBO), new entitlement spending in the plan would cost \$216 billion by 2019, then increase by 8 percent every year thereafter.
2. A Cornhusker Kickback for All. No, special deals aren’t removed from Obamacare this time around. Instead, the House bill extends new federal funding for Medicaid to all states. Incidentally, you’re paying for it.
3. A Freight train of taxes, slamming the American people in 2018. You’ve heard of the “Cadillac” tax on high-cost insurance plans? It will be pushed back to 2018, and given the way “high-cost” plans will be defined, a large segment of the middle class would get hit with the tax over time.
4. Beware the shape-shifting tax monster. New taxes will take many forms, including taxes on prescription drugs, medical devices (like wheel chairs), and health insurance.
5. Unconstitutional mandates, courtesy of Congress. Don’t want to buy health insurance? Congress will penalize you if you don’t, regardless of income.
6. Lock your back door. Higher health care costs will be sneaking in. The plan gives subsidies to low-to-moderate wage families, but the subsidies will increase at a lower rate than the rate at which premiums increase. In other words, those families will pay more every year.
7. Lights out for small businesses? Companies that hire certain low-income Americans will have to pay \$3,000 per employee, per year, even if the company offers insurance. Oh, and if a company employs 50 or more workers, they’ll face higher tax penalties to the tune of \$2,000 per full-time employee.
8. Abortions. You will pay for them, like it or not. The House bill includes major funding for community health centers with no restrictions on federal taxpayer funding of abortions.
9. Want to play the stock market? Maybe not, after you hear this. The House bill slaps a 3.8% tax on investment income.
10. It’s not a federal system, after all. States will have less power. They’ll no longer have authority to regulate health care premiums. Instead, the federal government will take on the job. States and local governments won’t be able to control their own employee health plans; they’ll have to abide by new federal regulations.



STATES ALIGN TO FILE LAWSUIT AGAINST STATE SOVEREIGNTY VIOLATIONS

Greg Abbott, Attorney General of Texas in a written statement late Sunday, said the state would act "to protect all Texans' constitutional rights, preserve the constitutional framework intended by our nation's founders, and defend our state from further infringement by the federal government."

Officials in at least 10 states have agreed to file a lawsuit. Some of the attorneys general, all of whom are Republicans, have said the bill violates state sovereignty by requiring that all Americans have some form of health insurance.

Several states have tried to take action: Virginia and Idaho have passed legislation aimed at blocking the bill's insurance requirement in their states.

"Just by virtue of being a resident of the United States, never before in history have we been required to purchase something," said Brian Gottstein, a spokesman for Virginia Attorney General Kenneth Cuccinelli, a Republican.

Many constitutional scholars say the efforts have no chance of succeeding for one simple reason: The Constitution establishes that national laws take precedence over state laws.

"They can sue, but I can't imagine a scenario in which a judge would enjoin the implementation of the federal health care bill," said Lawrence Friedman, a law professor at the New England School of Law in Boston.

Others say it is not that simple.

Dave Roland, a lawyer and policy analyst at the Show-Me Institute, a nonpartisan think tank in St. Louis, said the state constitutional amendments, which focus on creating rights for individuals, could make a plausible court challenge to the federal health care mandates. "There is a very distinct possibility that the Supreme Court might say that where you have a freedom secured by a state constitution that it might warrant protection, even against a federal statute," Roland said.

ANYTHING IT TAKES TO SOCIALIZE AMERICA
OBAMA'S NOMINEE FOR 9TH CIRCUIT COURT

"In Goodwin Liu's world, the Constitution requires redistribution of economic resources pretty much on a Marxist basis, to those according to their need from those according to their ability," said Ilya Shapiro, a legal analyst with the libertarian Cato Institute. "He thinks that because there's a social consensus he believes people should have things like food and health care, as a matter of policy."

Liu argues that the 14th Amendment should be interpreted to include "basic employment supports such as expanded health insurance, child care, transportation subsidies, job training, and a robust earned income tax credit."

Liu's record also includes explicit support for extending these rights to illegal aliens. In his view, the United States government is obligated to provide child care and health insurance to everyone within our borders.

This assessment of the 14th Amendment, and the Equal Protection clause, is one of the most severe examples of liberal constitutional interpretation in recent memory, says Shapiro. But Liu's appointment as Associate Dean and Professor of Law at the University of California Berkeley School of Law makes him uniquely suited to disseminate those views from an authoritative platform.

Liu was formerly with the American Civil Liberties Council of California, as well as the liberal American Constitution Society of Northern California. "He purports to advocate an approach based on constitutional fidelity," said Shapiro. "What this means to Liu is fidelity policy ideas of progressive judges that are interpreting the Constitution."

Liu staunchly against a traditional view of marriage and has ruled in favor of lawsuits protesting the mention of "God" in the Pledge of Allegiance. Before becoming a judge and academic, Liu practiced law for only two years.

There are enough Democratic Senators to make Liu's confirmation, slated for next month.

Through the Constitution, the Founders created an enduring framework of limited government based on the rule of law. They sought to secure national independence, provide for economic opportunity, establish true religious liberty and maintain a flourishing society of republican self-government. These principles define us as a country and inspire us as a people. They are responsible for a prosperous, just nation unlike any other in the world. They are our highest achievements, serving not only as powerful beacons to all who strive for freedom and seek self-government, but as warnings to tyrants and despots everywhere. Each one of these founding ideas is presently under sustained attack. In recent decades, America's principles have been undermined and redefined in our culture, our universities and our politics. The self-evident truths of 1776 have been supplanted by the notion that no such truths exist. The federal government today ignores the limits of the Constitution, which is increasingly dismissed as obsolete and irrelevant.

GOP COMMITTEE AGAIN FAVORS CLOSED PRIMARY

BOISE, Idaho (AP) - The Idaho Republican Party Central Committee on Saturday voted to press on with plans to close its primary. Rod Beck, an advocate of the closed primary, told The Associated Press that the Central Committee voted overwhelmingly to reject a recommendation passed at the June GOP state convention in Sandpoint that favored maintaining the 37-year-old open primary.

There's a federal court date in a Republican lawsuit against the state on Feb. 18 in U.S. District Court in Boise seeking to close the primary.

Beck and others want to close the primary because they think Democrats and independents are switching sides and skewing elections in favor of candidates who don't support Republican ideals.

* In 2008, there were 33 open primary states in which independent voters could participate in the presidential primaries and caucuses.

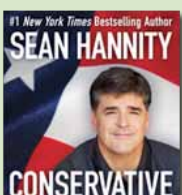
* In these states, 2.7 million independents voted for Barack Obama, giving him the margin of victory to secure the Democratic Party nomination.

* Party insiders (both Republican and Democratic) are attempting to eliminate open primaries and reassert their control of the electoral process.

Idaho is the site of one of the most important legal fights in the country. The Republican Party is seeking to institute partisan registration and closed primaries. In August, IndependentVoting.org and the American Movement of Idaho won the right to intervene in the lawsuit on behalf of the Idaho Secretary of State.

Upcoming Votes

Later in the week, the Senate is likely to begin work on this bill to make changes to the health care overhaul legislation Congress just passed and to revise student loan procedures.

- Small Business and Infrastructure Jobs Tax Act of 2010 - H.R.4849

The House is scheduled to vote on this bill to provide tax incentives for small business job creation, extend the Build America Bonds program, and provide other infrastructure job creation tax incentives.

- Disaster Relief and Summer Jobs Act of 2010 - H.R.4899

The House is also scheduled to work on this legislation that would provide funding for disaster relief, summer jobs and small business programs
